### Home Star “Cash for Caulkers”

- Proposed \$6 billion federal government rebate program for products and labor that reduce home energy bills
- **Gold Star** provides up to \$8,000 rebates or 50% of the cost whichever is less for whole house energy retrofits
- **Silver Star** provides \$500-\$1,500 rebates for prescriptive measures such as insulation, hot water heaters, windows, heating & air conditioning, doors, and duct work

*Sen. Snowe (R-ME): “Energy efficiency has been identified as the most cost effective method to reduce our dependency on foreign oil, cut carbon emissions, and save money for consumers on their energy bills. Home Star catalyzes energy efficiency into action and includes long-term tax incentives to make their homes state of the art.”*

### PACE

- Property Assessed Clean Energy financing program is approved in 22 states and saves money instantly
- This 20 year term, up to \$50,000 loan is for energy improvements and is tied to property taxes not consumer credit
- When the house is sold, the loan stays with the home

### Home Performance with Energy Star

- National program from the U.S. EPA and U.S. DOE that focuses on residential energy performance
- Locally sourced incentive and rebate programs sponsored by Energy Star
- Refunds thousands of dollars per home for energy audits, lighting, HVAC, insulation, windows, etc.

*SDGE: “The program is designed to be aligned with new and proposed efforts at the State and Federal level. It will allow customers to reduce energy usage while increasing the energy performance and comfort of their existing homes...”*

### Utility Whole House Retrofit Program

- California Public Utility Commission approved \$3 billion for an energy program with other nationwide utilities following suit
- Provides rebates for homeowners to make energy efficiency improvements
- Focuses on both whole house and prescriptive measures for the residential sector
